<b>Description</b>			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
The event was realized as a series of activities carried out over three days. Activities can be classified into four groups:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Strengthening the partnership with a view to its future</li> <li>- Eliminating discrimination, prejudice, gender inequality and marginalization</li> <li>- Support of intercultural dialogue in the form of presentation of cultural diversity</li> <li>- Increasing interest in the EU and supporting European citizenship</li> </ul>			

The implemented activities of the project were as follows:

Opening of the event - presentation of the CERV programme for citizens and media, presentation of the project, partners, financial support from the CERV Programme.

Come among us - interactive activities for all generations prepared by local associations, presentation of volunteering. An activity aimed at bringing citizens together. Domestic non-profit organizations and associations created a variable social program for participants from four countries to get to know each other. Associations presented the issue of volunteering and helping citizens in need.

The European Union and citizens - presentation of the basic principles of the functioning of the EU, its achievements, presentation of supported projects co-financed by the EU

The COVID-19 pandemic and its effects - a debate about the effects of the pandemic on the functioning of local communities. Exchange of know-how and debate on measures implemented to prevent community spread of coronavirus in individual countries.

Theatre performance - bringing citizens together and getting to know the local culture.

INFO EU – stand with promotional materials about the EU.

Market of traditional crafts and folk activities - presentation of traditions as an element of cultural identity.

Kulturpark – fun activities for all generations connected with getting to know the cultural wealth of the nations present.

Volunteering and its involvement in the life of municipalities – workshop + presentation of local volunteer associations. The workshop was devoted to the topics of solidarity and volunteering in practice.

Help counts - a discussion with representatives of the Civic Association BAGAR, which is dedicated to working with and supporting seniors, people with disabilities, national minorities and ethnic groups (Moravian minority, Roma minority, Ruthenian minority).

Folkloric heritage of nations - performances of folklore ensembles from partner municipalities. Introducing the role of culture in overcoming national barriers.

Music unites – performances by musical groups from partner municipalities.

Holy Mass - involvement of the religious element in overcoming prejudices and breaking down barriers.

Europe for the elderly - presentation of topics: solidarity with older people, active aging, support for seniors in EU countries.

Europe for young people - presentation of the European Solidarity Corps, the Erasmus+ programme.

The future of Europe - a discussion on how citizens imagine Europe and the partnership of municipalities. The outcome was getting to know the opinions of citizens of other countries and sharing an opinion on what kind of Europe we actually want.

Children and culture - performances by children's ensembles from partner municipalities.

End of the event - farewell to foreign participants, completion and evaluation of the project.
